Care & Cleaning

Daily Care and Cleaning:

PREPARE OVEN

1Press Power ON/OFF keypad to power-off oven. The fan will run to cool the oven interior faster. Allow oven to cool down to 200°F (95°C) (Approximately 10–15 minutes with the door open and 45–60 minutes with the door closed)

2Once cooled, carefully remove oven rack and other accessories from the cavity.

CLEAN OVEN RACK AND ACCESSORIES

3Clean the oven rack with liquid dishwashing detergent such as Dawn®, and a nonabrasive sponge or soft bristle brush. Allow to air-dry. **4**For other accessories, please refer to instructions included in original packaging.

CLEAN OVEN INTERIOR

5Remove baked-on particles using a plastic scouring pad.

6APPLY OVEN CLEANER: ⚠ Do NOT spray cleaning solution directly onto back-wall perforations. A Spray oven inner door, sides, and floor with ACP Oven Cleaner. Allow to soak 2–5 minutes. B Spray damp towel with ACP Oven Cleaner and wipe oven inner back-wall.

7CLEAN AND WIPE OVEN INTERIOR: Wipe the oven interior using a damp clean towel. Rinse towel and wring dry. Repeat 2–3 times to remove remaining cleaner and debris.

8APPLY OVEN SHIELD: When oven is clean, spray damp towel with ACP Oven Shield Protectant and wipe all interior surfaces. Do not remove ACP Oven Shield Protectant.

9Reinstall oven rack in oven.

Maintaining your oven every day ensures that your oven will have a longer operational life!

















Weekly Cleaning !!!!!

CLEAN AIR FILTER Air filter is located below oven door. A FOR OVENS WITH NON-REMOVABLE AIR FILTER: Wipe louvers using a damp clean towe. B FOR OVENS WITH MAGNETIC/REMOVABLE AIR FILTER: Remove magnetic air filter. Wash filter in a mild detergent solution made with warm water. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Reinstall filter on the oven base. For STYLE 1 ovens with AF10 accessory, see image B-1. For STYLE 2 ovens, see image B-2

• **CL10W** Cleaner, non-caustic spray for routine cleaning.

• PR10W Oven Shield protectant, non-caustic spray for routine cleaning
